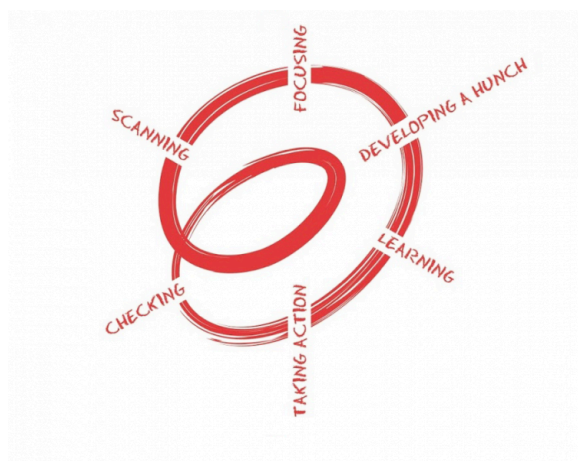
In alliance with Delta School District's Vision 2030, we strive to:
