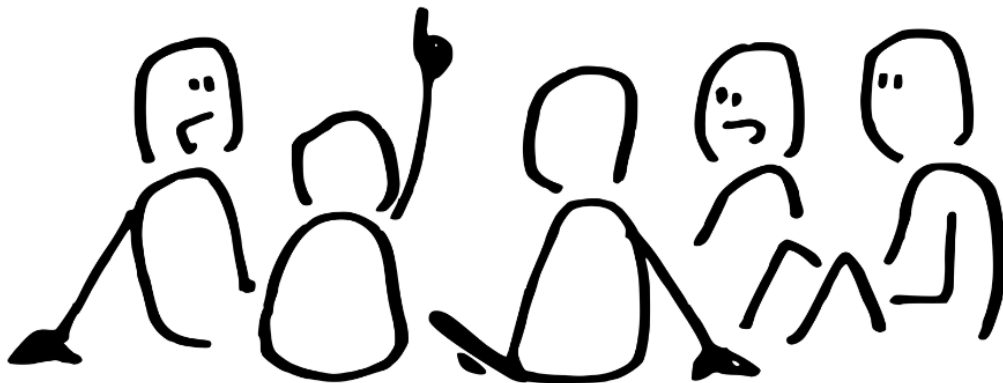
News from the Ladner EI PAC:

Roles & Responsibilities of a Ladner EI Parent Class Representative

What is a Parent Class Representative?

The role of a Parent Class Representative is designed to foster communication between the classroom teacher, PAC, and parents. The goal is to improve communication and create a community feel within a division by connecting families. ***By signing up to volunteer for parent class representative you are consenting to be contacted by the other parents in the classroom via email.***

Role of the Parent Class Representative

- Forward reminders or information to parents, as needed.
- Assist the teacher in sourcing helpers for activities/excursions, if required.
- Support parents, particularly new ones, by providing advice on where to go or who to ask for information when required.
- Help parents get to know each other and help students connect out in the community.
- Encourage parents to get involved with school and PAC activities in some way, however small, throughout the year.
- Communicate teacher requests to the PAC
