Reminders:

Remembrance Day Assembly:

- we will be holding our Remembrance Day Assembly on Monday, November 10th at 10:45 am
- to accommodate the start of our assembly, recess will take place from 9:50 – 10:05 am (40 minutes earlier than normal)
 - this will give students and staff time to go over expectations for the Remembrance Day Assembly and get poppies on students
- students who are guides, scouts and/or cadets are welcome and encouraged to wear their service uniforms to school on November 10th for our Remembrance Day Assembly
- our assembly will start with the *Land Acknowledgement*, and then transition into the *Entrance of the Flags* by the Colour Guard
 - the Colour Guard will be comprised of students who are guides, scouts, and cadets (these students must wear their service uniforms)
 - a sign-up for those students interested in being part of the Colour Guard will take place this Monday at Recess

- the school will begin collecting poppy donations (for the Royal Canadian Legion) this Monday and will continue to collect donations until November 10th (we encourage all our students and staff to donate to the poppy fund)
 - students can hand in any poppy donations to their classroom teachers
- the staff at Ladner Elementary are hoping to honour members of our community that:
 - are currently serving in the Canadian Armed Forces
 - have served in the Canadian Armed Forces
- we plan to honour these individuals by having them attend our Remembrance Day Assembly as honoured guests
 - please email Mr. Levenstein (klevenstein@deltaschools.ca) if you are a family member that is either serving in the Canadian Armed Forces or has served in the Canadian Armed Forces and is able to attend our assembly... we would love to have the opportunity to recognize you and thank you for your service!
- unfortunately, given the large number of students we have at Ladner Elementary, aside from any honoured guests, we will not have seating available for parents to watch our Remembrance Day Assembly

Observing Remembrance Day in the Community:



The Ladner Legion would like to invite families in Ladner to attend their Remembrance Day Ceremony. It will be held outdoors at the Cenotaph in Memorial Park on Tuesday, November 11th at 10:30 am. The ceremony will begin with a parade from the Legion Hall on Delta Street and proceed to the Cenotaph in Memorial Park. Once the parade reaches the park at the Cenotaph, the regular ceremony will start. This solemn ceremony will provide the Ladner community with an opportunity to remember and reflect on those who served and died protecting Canadian values. Local veterans, political representatives, emergency services, community service clubs, cadets, and other youth groups will be participating in this public event. Student representatives from Ladner Elementary have been invited to lay a wreath on the school's behalf.
